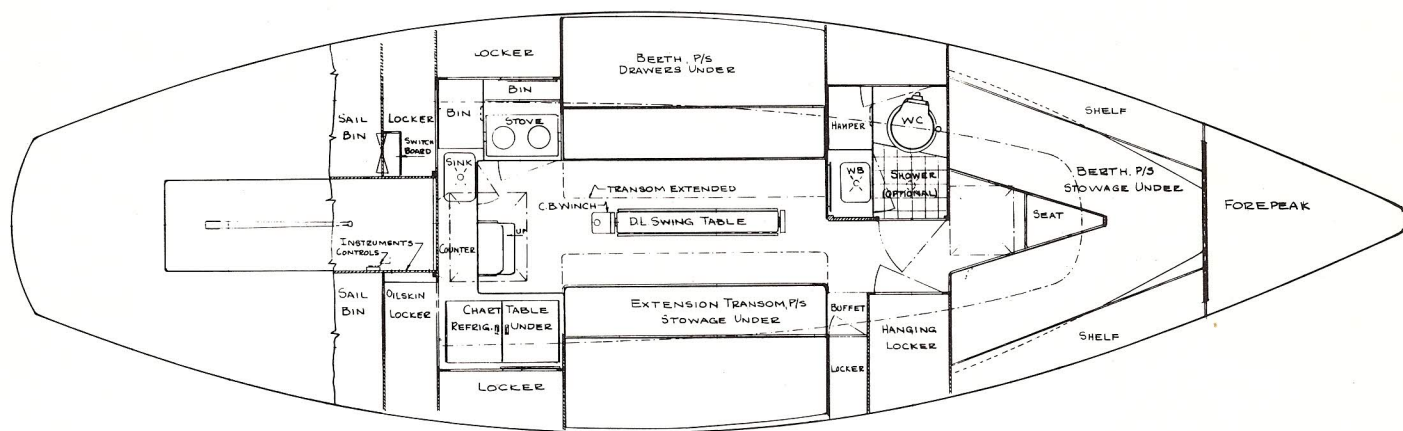
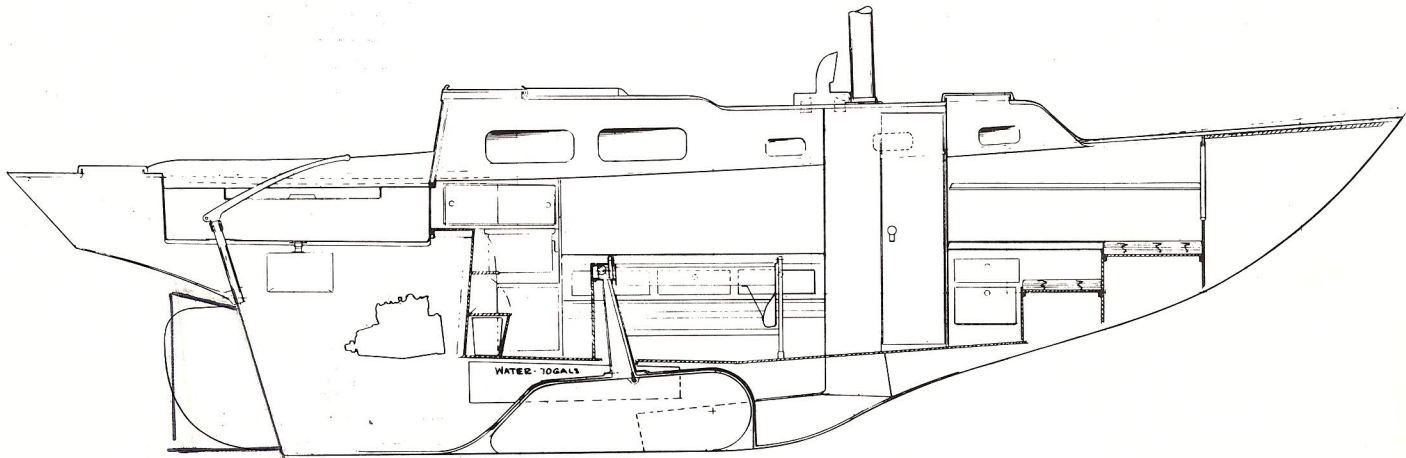
A centerboard auxiliary for ocean racing and cruising.

Seabreeze is a modern, ocean-going centerboarder of a type that has manifested its qualities in many recent deepwater races. Accommodations are for six, with four berths in the main cabin (two built-in, two transoms), and two 6' 6" berths forward. Headroom is 6' 3". Abundant drawer and locker facilities, including oilskin locker. Six opening bronze ports. Hardware is bronze; standing rigging is stainless

steel; spars are aluminum with roller reefing. The 400 lb. streamlined bronze centerboard is easily operated with a Merriman Centerboard Winch. Two No. 5 winches are provided for the jib sheets, and a No. 2 for the jib halyard. Large opening cockpit seats. Wood trim above and below decks. Seabreeze is designed to rate well under C.C.A. and other popular rules, and to provide the keenest competition.
